COCKTAILS

All cocktails are £9.00

Sours

Choose from Maker's Mark bourbon, Disaronno amaretto or Portón pisco. Then shaken with lemon, lime juice and egg white.

Cosmopolitan

With our Cosmo we use Absolut vodka, Giffard triple sec, cranberry and lime juice.

Daiquiri

Daiquiri is a classic cocktail named after a beach in Cuba. We use a healthy measure of Havana 3-Year white rum, lime juice and sugar.

Espresso Martini

The espresso martini is all you need to finish a great dinner. We use real espresso here with Absolut vanilla vodka, Kahlúa and vanilla infused sugar syrup.

Mojito

The mojito is one of the most famous rum-based highballs, traditionally made up of five ingredients; Havana 3-Year rum, sugar, lime juice, soda water and mint.

Negroni

The Negroni is a classic Italian aperitif cocktail. We use Tanqueray gin, Belsazar Red vermouth and Amaro Mondino.

Old Fashioned

One of the classic cocktails, made with brown sugar dissolved in Angostura bitters, Maker's Mark bourbon and muddled orange.

Gin/Vodka Martini

We use Belsazar dry vermouth and Cotswold vodka or Sipsmith gin. We serve our martini's the classic way dirty or with a twist.

Margarita

Our classic margarita includes Espolón Tequila Blanco, Cointreau and lime juice, served with salt on the rim.

Bellini

Traditionally the Bellini is a mixture of Prosecco and peach purée or nectar. Please ask what seasonal flavours we have available for our take on this popular aperitif.

Julien's signature wine, sourced from St Véran vineyards that are soon to be awarded 1er Cru status, has a wonderful, rich and opulent mouth feel, with stone-fruit flavours, a slight floral lift and weighty body.

Rully 2014, David Moret

£60.00

Rich, creamy and perfectly balanced with great tension and minerality. Moret has excelled with this moreish white Burgundy.

Chablis 1er Cru "Beauroy" 2008, Dom. Verret

£67.00

A beautiful wine aged enough to give some pear, dried apricots, spices like cloves, developing into notes of butter and toasted bread. Rich and rounded, delicate but still vivid. This Chablis has reached it's full maturity and is ready to be enjoyed.

Herve Kerlann is making a name for himself making some top-flight Côte de Nuits reds. This Bourgogne Rouge is sourced from vineyards surrounding Volnay and is exceptionally elegant and fine.

Pommard always stands out from being a bit different amongst the big appellations of Burgundy. The feminine style of the pinot noir is still present, but, it's more earthy, deeper and spicier. It will continue to improve throughout your meal.
